Migration as a Sign of the Times Perspectives from social sciences and theology

Salzburg, 12 – 14 April 2012

The contested realities of migration in a globalized world raise complex issues and call for a multi-dimensional analysis. The conference is dedicated to an interdisciplinary approach to migration and will engage perspectives from sociology, politology, discourse analysis, philosophy and theology. The various point of views are brought into dialogue and – in an extended phase of plenary discussion – analyzed as to their mutual implications, thus bringing an evolving theology of migration further on the way.
